Lower Murray Flood Plain Launch

2nd October 2013

Regional Development Australia Murraylands & Riverland (RDA MR) on behalf of the Lower Murray Flood Plain Working Group would like to announce that the *Lower Murray Flood Plain Land Use Study and Development Plan Review* will be formally launched on Tuesday 22nd October.

The LMFP report, developed by URPS on behalf of the Lower Murray Flood Plain working group has been undertaken over the past six months to identify viable current and future land use options for the floodplain between Mannum and Wellington. The report makes four key recommendations that will pave the way for all necessary change and adaptation required to achieve maximum potential for the study area, including suggested planning amendments.

The Launch, to be officiated by the Shadow Minister for Planning Transport and Infrastructure Ms Vickie Chapman MP, will be held at the Murray Bridge Golf Club at 3.30pm on Tuesday 22nd October 2013. The Lower Murray Flood Plain project is the result of successful collaboration between RDA Murraylands & Riverland, the Rural City of Murray Bridge, the Mid Murray Council, the Coorong District Council, Primary Industries and Regions SA (PIRSA), the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA), the South Australian Murray Darling Basin Natural Resources Management Board (SA MDB NRM), and the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI).
