The Primary Health Care Grants Calendar (PHCGC) is a concise, user-friendly and condensed appraisal of grants currently available. The aim of the PHCGC is to provide a broad range of rural workers and communities with up to date information regarding current grant and funding opportunities to address identified community needs. This allows for innovative and creative initiatives to be undertaken locally. The PHCGC process contributes to the development of partnerships between government, non government and community groups. It also provides an opportunity for communities to become empowered and thus developing a community capacity building process, therefore enabling communities to take control of their future.

The PHCGC is prepared by CHSA cluster areas on a rotation basis for Country Health SA. Resources utilised to compile the PHCGC include Service SA -Grants Directory and the Easy Grants newsletter. Only small selections of specific grants that have a primary health care focus relevant to the areas have been included.
